



LUFA DONATIONS POLICY (Updated: January 2020)

Throughout the year, LUFA receives numerous requests for financial assistance. The Association's response will be guided by the following policy.

1. BARGAINING AND STRIKES

Strike funding support covers a varied group of unions. The following schedule shall guide LUFA's support:

Faculty Unions (CAUT)	\$1,500
Other Laurentian University Unions	\$1,500
Other Faculty Unions	\$1,000
Sudbury Unions	\$1,000
Other Unions	\$ 750

Such amounts will be authorized for payment to Faculty Unions, or upon receiving written request from other unions, by the LUFA Executive on the recommendation of the Secretary/Treasurer. In the case of faculty strikes lasting over one week, the Executive shall have the power to provide assistance to other Faculty Unions according to current practice for members of the CAUT Defence Fund, and taking into account LUFA's budgetary means. The Executive may modify the actual payments made.

2. CHARITABLE DONATIONS

The amount of \$2,000 will be set aside annually for the purpose of charitable donations. **Such donations must have a relationship to the purposes of LUFA as a union or as an association as per article 2 of its Constitution.** Payment will be authorized upon written request from a member of LUFA, and must be approved by the LUFA Executive on the recommendation of the Secretary and Treasurer. Educative activities for members shall be financed under the Member Education budget if deemed appropriate.

3. COMPASSION - DECEASED MEMBER

Should any active member of LUFA pass away, LUFA shall provide a payment of \$200.00 in memory of the deceased to a designated foundation or other proper venue.
